## INTRODUCTION OF PUBLIC HEARING Battery Park Apartments

This is a public hearing regarding the Authority's plan to issue multifamily housing revenue bonds in an amount up to \$1,000,000 to finance a portion of the cost of the acquisition, rehabilitation and equipping of a multifamily residential rental facility known as Battery Park Apartments, consisting of 122 units and located at approximately 1 Battle Square in the City of Asheville, Buncombe County, North Carolina.

The proceeds of the bonds will be loaned to Battery Park (TC2) Senior Housing Limited Partnership, a North Carolina limited partnership, and used by the company, together with equity from related 4% low income housing tax credits and other sources of funding, to acquire, rehabilitate and equip the development, which will be operated as affordable housing. The owner and operator of the affordable housing will be solely responsible for the repayment of the bonds; the Authority will not be responsible for the operation of the apartments or the repayment of the bonds.

Under the federal tax code, the issuance of the bonds must be approved by the City Council of the City of Asheville following a public hearing. Notice of the public hearing was published in the *Asheville Citizen-Times* on February 19, 2025.

The public hearing with respect to the issuance by the Authority of its bonds to finance the acquisition, rehabilitation and equipping of Battery Park Apartments is hereby opened.
