
THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF ASHEVILLE

WHEREAS, R. L. Ellis, Chairman, and W. J. Dumbolt, Arthur E. Dunn, A. T. Rust, and Wayne Henslett, Commissioners, having been appointed as such by Helms Bryson, Mayor of the City of Asheville, North Carolina, to act as an Authority under the Housing Authorities Law, being Chapter 486 of the Public Laws of 1938, and desiring to become a public body and a body corporate and politic under said Law, and

WHEREAS, the said Commissioners have filed in the Office of Secretary of State for the State of North Carolina, an application for a certificate of incorporation, in accordance with Section 4 of said Law, under the name of the HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF ASHEVILLE, which application was accompanied by exhibits showing full compliance with said Law and has been filed and recorded as of this day.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, THAD BURE, Secretary of State for the State of North Carolina, do hereby certify that the above named Commissioners and their successors in office, are duly incorporated as a public body and a body corporate and politic under the provisions of said Law under the name of the HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF ASHEVILLE, with perpetual succession, for the purposes set forth in the said Housing Authorities Law, with all of the powers and privileges conferred by said Law.

**CERTIFICATE OF APPOINTMENT OF COMMISSIONERS
OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF

DESIGNATION OF THE FIRST CHAIRMAN**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Asheville, North Carolina, held a duly authorized regular meeting on the 30th day of May, 1940; and

WHEREAS, at said meeting the following resolution was passed and adopted:

RESOLUTION

RESOLUTION DETERMINING THAT THERE IS A NEED IN THE CITY OF ASHEVILLE AND SURROUNDING TERRITORY FOR A HOUSING AUTHORITY

WHEREAS, a petition signed by twenty-five and more citizens of the City of Asheville having been presented to the City Council of the City of Asheville requesting that a survey be made, and that a Housing Authority be appointed for said city and area under Chapter 456 of the Public Laws of 1935; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Asheville, after due consideration and investigation, has determined that the conditions of insanitation and unsafe inhabited dwelling accommodations exist in the city and the surrounding area, and therefore having determined same find that said conditions exist; and

WHEREAS, all law having been complied with up to this time under Section 4 of Chapter 456 of the Public Laws of 1935;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ASHEVILLE:

That they do find as a fact that insanitation and unsafe inhabited dwelling accommodations exist in the City of Asheville and the surrounding area, as set out in Section 4 of Chapter 456 of the Public Laws of 1935.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Honorable Helmes Bryson, Mayor of the City of Asheville is hereby officially notified of such condition and of the passage of this resolution, and is hereby respectfully requested to proceed according to law, namely, to name five commissioners to act as the said Housing Authority.

I move the adoption of the foregoing resolution.

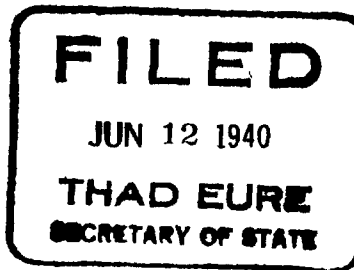

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APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE
OF INCORPORATION FOR THE

TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE OF NORTH CAROLINA:

The undersigned, R. L. ELLIS, W. J. DAMTOFT, ARTHUR E. DUNN, A. T. RUST, and WAYNE BRAMLETT, hereby apply for a Certificate of Incorporation for the Housing Authority of the City of Asheville, pursuant to the Housing Authorities Law, being Chapter 456 of the Public Laws of 1935, and to that end do respectfully show:

1. (a) That a petition has been filed with the City Clerk of the City of Asheville by twenty-five residents of said City and of the area within ten miles from the territorial boundary lines thereof, setting forth that there is a need for a housing authority to function in said City and said surrounding area.
- (b) That upon the filing of said petition the said City Clerk gave due notice that public hearing would be held by the City Council of the City of Asheville at the usual meeting place of said Council at 4:30 o'clock P. M. the ~~30th~~ day of ~~April~~, 1940, and that at said time and place an opportunity to be heard would be granted to all the residents and taxpayers of the aforesaid territory and all other interested persons; that said notice was published in The Asheville Times, a newspaper having a general circulation in said City and surrounding area, at least ten days preceding the date on which the said public hearing was had.
- (c) That said public hearing was duly had at the time and place aforesaid and upon the conclusion thereof and on the 30th day of May, 1940, in regular meeting, the Board of Commissioners of said City duly adopted a resolution in which it was determined that insanitary or unsafe inhabited dwelling accommodations existed in the said City and said surrounding area and that there was a lack of safe or sanitary dwelling accommodations in the said City and said surrounding area available for all of the inhabitants thereof.
- (d) That the Mayor of said City has appointed the undersigned as Commissioners for the Housing Authority to be incorporated hereunder as will more fully hereinafter appear.
